Just lately, we've been innundated with submissionns for a contest. We finally reached your <u>Weird Tales</u> submission, "Dial Tone." Alas -- not for us. Most stories need to establish the time and place -- the <u>setting</u> of the story -- as soon as possible. In a few stories (but not this one), this uncertainty is deliberate, as when the viewpoint character wakes with amnesia. In almost every story, establish the gender of the viewpoint character as quickly as possible. We did like the throwaway details. And you told the reader far too little about the protagonist's personality or motives. In our <u>Guidelines</u>, please note the discussion of stapling and italics/underlining.
